Activities & Initiatives:

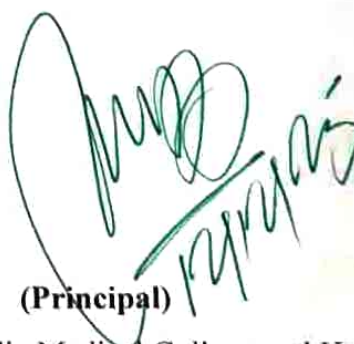
- Annual Student Orientation Program
